She serves in a leadership capacity in such complex litigation matters as In re Musical Instruments and Equip. Antitrust Litig. (Lead/Liaison Counsel); Wixon v. Wyndham Resort Devel. Corp. (Class Counsel); and In Re California Title Ins. Antitrust Litig. (Co-Lead Counsel). Ms. Pritzker is a member of the American Association for Justice (AAJ), CAOC and SFTLA.

The Honorable Winifred Y. Smith was appointed to the Alameda County Superior Court in 2000 by Governor Gray Davis, and currently serves as the Court's Supervising Direct Calendar Judge. She served as Civil Direct Calendar Judge from 2007 to 2010, and as Civil Law and Motion Judge from 2006 to 2007. Judge Smith is the 2010 recipient of the Alameda County Bar Association's "Distinguished Service" Award. In 2006, she was honored by the Charles Houston Bar Association with its "Judge of the Year" Award.

Mike Danko specializes in catastrophic personal injury, wrongful death, products liability and aviation disasters. His offices are in San Mateo but he tries cases throughout the United States. In 2009, Mr. Danko was honored with a Trial Lawyer of the Year nomination from the CAOC. In 2010, he was named one of the Best Lawyers in America. He is a member of AAJ, the Lawyer Pilots Bar Association and CAOC, where he serves on the board of governors.

Jennie Lee Anderson is a partner at the law firm of Andrus Anderson LLP in San Francisco. She represents exclusively plaintiffs in a variety of matters, including class action, employment, product liability, civil rights, antitrust, personal injury and mass tort cases.
